#### Initial Enrollment Period (IEP)

If you are new to Medicare, you can enroll during your Initial Enrollment Period (IEP); the three months before, the month of, and the three months after your Part B effective date. Once you have been enrolled in a Medicare Plan, you can only make changes during the Annual Enrollment Period (AEP). Please be aware of the AEP dates are now October 15<sup>th</sup> to December 7<sup>th</sup>. This will give you a January 1<sup>st</sup> effective date for your new plan.

#### Annual Enrollment Period (AEP)

Applications must be signed and dated on, or between October 15<sup>th</sup> and December 7<sup>th</sup>. *If they are signed prior to October 15<sup>th</sup> they will be returned to you with a new application.* If they are received after December 7<sup>th</sup>, you will not be able to change plans until the next AEP for January of the following year.

#### Special Enrollment Period (SEP)

There are a number of reasons for Special Enrollments; Loss of a job that provides benefits, death of a spouse who's plan provided benefits, moving to an area where your old plan is not available, etc...

#### **Understanding the benefits**

Review the full list of benefits found in the Evidence of Coverage (EOC), especially those services for which you routinely see a doctor. Visit <b>www.aetnamedicare.com</b> or call <b>1-833-859-6031 (TTY: 711)</b> to view a copy of the EOC.
Review the provider directory (or ask your doctor) to make sure the doctors you see now are in the network. If they are not listed, it means you will likely have to select a new doctor.
Review the pharmacy directory to make sure the pharmacy you use for any prescription medicine is in the network. If the pharmacy is not listed, you will likely have to select a new pharmacy for your prescriptions.

### **Understanding important rules**

In addition to your monthly plan premium, you must continue to pay your Medicare Part B premium. This premium is normally taken out of your Social Security check each month.
Benefits, premiums and/or copayments/co-insurance may change on January 1, 2022.
Our plan allows you to see providers outside of our network (non-contracted providers). However, while we will pay for covered services provided by a non-contracted provider, the provider must agree to treat you. Except in an emergency or urgent situations, non-contracted providers may deny care. In addition, you may pay a higher co-pay for services received by non-contracted providers.

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Aetna Medicare is a HMO, PPO plan with a Medicare contract. Our SNPs also have contracts with State Medicaid programs. Enrollment in our plans depends on contract renewal.

Out-of-network/ non-contracted providers are under no obligation to treat Aetna members, except in emergency situations. The formulary, provider and/or pharmacy network may change at any time. You will receive notice when necessary. Medicare's pharmacy network includes limited lower cost, preferred pharmacies in: Rural Kansas, Rural Nebraska, Rural Maine, Rural Michigan, Suburban Arizona, Suburban West Virginia, and Urban Michigan. The lower costs advertised in our plan materials for these pharmacies may not be available at the pharmacy you use. For up-to-date information about our network pharmacies, including whether there are any lower-cost preferred pharmacies in your area, members please call the number on your ID card, non-members please call 1-833-859-6031 (TTY: 711) or consult the online pharmacy directory at www.aetnamedicare.com/findpharmacy. For mail-order, you can get prescription drugs shipped to your home through the network mailorder delivery program. Typically, mail-order drugs arrive within 10 days. You can call the number on your ID card if you do not receive your mail-order drugs within this timeframe. Members may have the option to sign-up for automated mail-order delivery. Members who get "Extra Help" are not required to fill prescriptions at preferred network pharmacies in order to get Low Income Subsidy (LIS) copays. Participating physicians, hospitals and other health care providers are independent contractors and are neither agents nor employees of Aetna. The availability of any particular provider cannot be guaranteed, and provider network composition is subject to change.

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
