#### Initial Enrollment Period (IEP)

If you are new to Medicare, you can enroll during your Initial Enrollment Period (IEP); the three months before, the month of, and the three months after your Part B effective date. Once you have been enrolled in a Medicare Plan, you can only make changes during the Annual Enrollment Period (AEP). Please be aware of the AEP dates are now October 15<sup>th</sup> to December 7<sup>th</sup>. This will give you a January 1<sup>st</sup> effective date for your new plan.

#### Annual Enrollment Period (AEP)

Applications must be signed and dated on, or between October 15<sup>th</sup> and December 7<sup>th</sup>. *If they are signed prior to October 15<sup>th</sup> they will be returned to you with a new application.* If they are received after December 7<sup>th</sup>, you will not be able to change plans until the next AEP for January of the following year.

#### Special Enrollment Period (SEP)

There are a number of reasons for Special Enrollments; Loss of a job that provides benefits, death of a spouse who's plan provided benefits, moving to an area where your old plan is not available, etc...

#### Who can join?

To join PacificSource Medicare MyCare Rx 39 (HMO) or MyCare Rx 40 (HMO), you must be entitled to Medicare Part A, be enrolled in Medicare Part B, and live in our service area. Our service area includes the following counties in Oregon: Clackamas, Multnomah, and Washington.

## Which doctors, hospitals, and pharmacies can I use?

PacificSource Medicare MyCare Rx 39 (HMO) and MyCare Rx 40 (HMO) have a network of doctors, hospitals, pharmacies, and other providers. If you use the providers that are not in our network, the plan may not pay for these services. Exceptions are emergencies, urgent care, and out-of-area dialysis services.

You must generally use network pharmacies to fill your prescriptions for covered Part D drugs. Some of our network pharmacies have preferred cost-sharing. You may pay less if you use these pharmacies.

#### What do we cover?

- Our plan members get <u>all</u> of the benefits covered by Original Medicare. For some of these benefits, you may pay more in our plan than you would in Original Medicare. For others, you may pay less.
- Our plan members also get more than what is covered by Original Medicare. Some of the extra benefits are outlined in this booklet.

We cover Part D drugs. In addition, we cover Part B drugs, such as chemotherapy and some drugs administered by your provider.

#### How will I determine my drug costs?

You may get your drugs at network retail pharmacies and mail order pharmacies. Cost-sharing may differ relative to the pharmacy's status as preferred or standard, mail-order, Long Term Care (LTC) or home infusion, and 30-, 60-, or 90-day supply.

If you reside in a long-term care facility, you pay the same as at a retail pharmacy.

We do not cover prescription drugs purchased outside of the United States and its territories.
